MADE by the Minister of Finance under section 70(1)(c) of the Customs Ordinance.

Citation, commencement and duration

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Import Duty Exemption)(No. 2) Order 2017 and shall come into operation on 1st November 2017 and will expire on 31st December 2017.

Import duty exemption

2. Subject to the conditions contained in paragraph 3 and notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Customs Tariff (General) Order, import duty shall not be payable in respect of goods of any description specified in the Schedule imported into the Islands during the period specified in paragraph 1.

Conditions

3. (1) The import duty exemption shall apply to individuals only.

(2) An individual seeking to import goods of the description specified in the Schedule and to be granted the import duty exemption under paragraph 2 shall on importation of any such goods produce to the Collector—

- (a) evidence of ownership of the damaged property or of long term residence at the property;
- (b) evidence of damage to furniture or appliances, either through photographs or insurance assessment; and
- (c) proof of value of the replacement furniture or appliance, either by invoice or quotation.
