Businesses and persons appearing on the register are required to contact the Revenue Department on or before July 1st 2014.

Please be reminded that operators of businesses that have ceased operations are required under section 8 & 9 of the Business Licensing Ordinance to give notice of changes in the particulars of the business, including the date the business ceased to operate. There are penalties for failing to adhere to these requirements which have been expressly provided in writing to all Licensees.

This is the final appeal; Failure to comply will result in legal proceedings against all businesses that are operating without a valid business license. For further details, please contact;
